## Traumatic Brain Injury Fund

#### History of the Fund

Since July 2013, the General Assembly has allocated funding for Delaware's Traumatic Brain Injury Trust Fund.

#### **Covered Services**

Covered services under Delaware's Traumatic Brain Injury Trust Fund may include the following medically necessary services specifically related to a traumatic brain injury (not covered under DHSS Medicaid Programs):

- Driving Assessment & Driver Rehabilitation
- Assistive Technology
- Medically approved summer day camps
- Short-term attendant services not covered by other funding
- Prisms for eyeglasses
- Vision Therapy
- Home and Environmental Modifications
- Other services, treatments, or therapies pre-approved by the TBI Fund Committee.

#### **Eligibility Requirements**

To qualify for funding applicants must fully complete an application and supporting documentation and meet these requirements:

- ❖ Must be a FT Delaware resident.
- Provide denial of service letters from existing insurance.
- Have medical documentation of a traumatic brain injury.

#### **Documented Brain Injury**

The documentation of a brain injury can include, but is not limited to the following:

- Discharge Summary
- Recent treatment notes
- Neurological Examination
- Neuropsychological evaluation
- Neuroimaging
- Certification of Diagnosis from a Licensed Medical Provider in good standing.
