Traumatic Brain Injury Fund

History of the Fund

Since July 2013, the General Assembly has allocated funding for Delaware's Traumatic Brain Injury Trust Fund.

Covered Services

Covered services under Delaware's Traumatic Brain Injury Trust Fund may include the following medically necessary services specifically related to a traumatic brain injury (not covered under DHSS Medicaid Programs):

- ❖ Driving Assessment & Driver Rehabilitation
- ❖ Assistive Technology
- ❖ Medically approved summer day camps
- ❖ Short-term attendant services not covered by other funding
- ❖ Prisms for eyeglasses
- ❖ Vision Therapy
- ❖ Home and Environmental Modifications
- ❖ Other services, treatments, or therapies pre-approved by the TBI Fund Committee.

Eligibility Requirements

To qualify for funding applicants must fully complete an application and supporting documentation and meet these requirements:

- ❖ Must be a FT Delaware resident.
- ❖ Provide denial of service letters from existing insurance.
- ❖ Have medical documentation of a traumatic brain injury.

Documented Brain Injury

The documentation of a brain injury can include, but is not limited to the following:

- ❖ Discharge Summary
- ❖ Recent treatment notes
- ❖ Neurological Examination
- ❖ Neuropsychological evaluation
- ❖ Neuroimaging
- ❖ Certification of Diagnosis from a Licensed Medical Provider in good standing.
