RE: HB 401 Exempting FDA Approved Medications from Controlled Substances

The proposed legislation Reported Out of the House Health & Human Development Committee on Committee on 5/9/18. HB 401 seeks to exempt federally lawful FDA approved marijuana containing products from Schedule I of the state Controlled Substances Act. This is being proposed in anticipation of FDA approval of drugs using cannabidiol in the treatment of certain pediatric seizure disorders. Taking such medications off Schedule I will hasten access to the medications once approved and available. This will also improve access to other similar medications that may be approved in the future.

The SCPD is <u>endorsing</u> this measure to improve access to effective treatments for serious pediatric seizure disorders.
