RE: H.B. 75 (Eliminate the Limitations as to When an Individual May  
Vote by Absentee Ballot)

The State Council for Persons with Disabilities (SCPD) has reviewed H.B. 75, which is the final leg of a constitutional amendment that would eliminate, from the Delaware Constitution, the limitations as to when an individual may vote by absentee ballot. This amendment to the Delaware Constitution provides that the General Assembly shall enact general laws providing the circumstances, rules, and procedures for absentee voting.

SCPD endorses the proposed legislation since it expands access to the process.
